

Dr. Lutz Mellinger elected to be new Chairman of the Supervisory Board at itelligence AG

Bielefeld, November 14, 2007 – Dr. Lutz Mellinger, 65, a member of the itelligence Supervisory Board since 2003, was today elected to become the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of itelligence AG in an extraordinary meeting of the Supervisory Board. He succeeds Prof. Peter-Jürgen Kreher, who recently died unexpectedly at the age of 73.
